

2023 Annual Fugitive Dust Control Report

This annual fugitive dust control report has been developed to describe the actions taken by the City of Grand Haven to control Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Fugitive dust, to record any citizen complaints and to provide a summary of any corrective actions taken. CCR generated at the former JB Sims (JBS) Generating Station was stored in two CCR units: (1) the inactive Units 1/2 Impoundment and (2) the former Unit 3A/B Impoundments. These units are no longer in use and CCR is no longer being managed. The Generating Station ceased operation in 2020. Coal ash was removed from the Unit 3A/B Impoundments and disposed offsite and any coal ash that may be present in the Units 1/2 Impoundment is located under surface water with no potential to become fugitive dust.

Access to the site is controlled and public access is restricted. There were no construction activities on site.


Citizen Complaints
